

Dress Code for 8th Grade Promotion

Young Women:

Dresses:

- Strapless dresses **are not allowed**; this includes strapless dresses with a removable shawl and dresses with one strap
- Straps of any width, including spaghetti straps **are** allowed.
- Halter top (straps tie behind the neck) dresses **are not allowed**.
- Dresses should be no shorter than the uniform skirt (just above the knee and no more than 4 inches from the ground when kneeling on a level surface). This includes illusion dresses and slits.
- Dresses should have a modest cut and fit. Exposed mid to lower back dresses as well as low-cut tops **are not allowed**.
- Dresses should not be overly tight or loose.
- Cut outs **are not allowed**.
- Bare midriffs **are not allowed**.
- Sweetheart tops **are** allowed if they are modestly cut.

Shoes/Hair/Accessories:

- Heel height should be no higher than 4 inches.
- Hair should be standard uniform, natural colors, one hair adornment, etc.
- Larger earrings, bracelets, and necklaces **are** allowed.
- Bolder makeup (false eyelashes, eyeliner, mascara, blush, etc.) **is** allowed, but should be tastefully done.
- Undergarments should **not** be visible.

Young Men:

Dress slacks, a collared dress shirt, tie, dark socks and standard uniform hair are required.
